WHEREAS, in an effort to ensure the safe and sound operation of Banco de Chile, New York, New York (“Branch”), a Federal branch of Banco de Chile, Santiago, Chile (“Bank”), the Branch, by and through the Managing Director of the International Area, and the Bank, by and through its General Manager, consented to the issuance of a Consent Order (“Order”) dated February 1, 2005 against the Branch and the Bank by the Comptroller of the Currency of the United States of America (“Comptroller”); and

WHEREAS, the Bank voluntarily liquidated the Branch, and the Branch relinquished its Federal branch license effective March 13, 2008;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Comptroller directs that the Order dated February 1, 2005 be, and it hereby is, TERMINATED.
