**TERMINATION ORDER**

WHEREAS, in an effort to protect depositors, customers, and shareholders of insured depository institutions and institutions specified in 12 U.S.C. § 1818(e)(7)(A) (collectively “insured depository institutions”), Anthony M. Angiulli (“Angiulli”) and the Office of Thrift Supervision (“OTS”)<sup>1</sup> stipulated to the issuance of Consent Order of Prohibition (“Order”) signed June 27, 1991, pursuant to 12 U.S.C. § 1818(e) in connection with his activities at Mt. Troy Savings and Loan Association, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The Order prohibited Angiulli from participating in the conduct of the affairs of an insured depository institution;

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the Currency (“Comptroller”) believes that the Order is no longer necessary to ensure the protection of customers, depositors, and shareholders of insured depository institutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Comptroller orders the termination of the Order.
