WHEREAS, in an effort to protect the depositors, other customers and shareholders of First National Community Bank, Chatsworth, Georgia (“Bank”), and to ensure the Bank's safe and sound operation, the Bank, then operating under the name “The First National Bank of Chatsworth,”¹ by and through its duly elected and acting Board of Directors, and the Comptroller of the Currency of the United States (“Comptroller”) entered into a Consent Order, No. AA-EC-10-123, dated January 20, 2011 (“2011 Order”); and

WHEREAS, the Comptroller believes that the protection of the depositors, other customers and shareholders of the Bank as well as its safe and sound operation do not require the continued existence of said 2011 Order;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Comptroller directs that the said 2011 Order (No. AA-EC-10-123) be, and it hereby is, **TERMINATED**.
