WHEREAS, in an effort to protect the depositors, other customers and shareholders of Mission National Bank, San Francisco, California (“Bank”), and to ensure the Bank’s operation in accordance with safe and sound banking practices and certain laws, rules and regulations, the Bank, by and through its duly elected Board of Directors, consented to the issuance of a Consent Order on March 22, 2012 (“Order”) against the Bank by the Comptroller of the Currency of the United States of America (“Comptroller”); and

WHEREAS, the Comptroller believes that the protection of the depositors, other customers and shareholders of the Bank, as well as the Bank’s safe and sound operation do not require the continued existence of the Order;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Comptroller directs that the Order dated March 22, 2012 be, and hereby is, TERMINATED.
